Jury declared mistrial. 1972-1982 Senior Fellow at Institute for Policy Studies. 1973-1975 first director of its overseas affiliate, the Transnational Institute in Amsterdam. In 1982 joined Hampshire College in Amherst, MA where he taught world politics and political science. Retired 1997. Granted parcel of land in Pakistan by Prime Minister Benazir Bhutto's government to build an independent alternative university, Khaldunia (but land was later seized by her husband for golf course). Died in Islamabad May 11, 1999 of heart failure following surgery for colon cancer diagnosed just one week before. 2 million people displaced by partition of India in 1947! Hindu nationalism replaced previous 700 years of Indo-Muslim civilization that had been syncretic (not exclusionary). Mahatma Gandhi returned from South Africa in 1915. Earlier Russo-Japanese war 1904-1905 proved Asians could beat colonialist.
